



The University of Camerino – International School of Advanced Studies invites applications from those wishing to participate in the 22nd edition of PhD courses in the following scientific areas:

To the total number of available places, 8 further places (4 with fellowships, 2 of which reserved for non-EU candidates) will be added and assigned according to the general merit list (see below) and to the merit list established by the Graduate School Committee for EU candidates and non-EU candidates, respectively. Places without fellowship, available in the different scientific areas will be assigned to EU or non-EU candidates on the basis of the two merit lists, respectively.

The selection is open to graduates in possession of a university-awarded master's degree or its equivalent. The Graduate School Committee will rule on the validity of the degree qualification. In case the University degree of the candidate is not officially recognized as equivalent, the Graduate School Committee will decide on the validity of the degree qualification obtained abroad for the only purpose of participating in the selection. The selection is also open to candidates who do not possess already the requested degree, unless conferment will take place within the date of examination.

For the selection examination the Rector will designate specific boards composed of 3 professors from the pertinent scientific areas, upon proposal of the Graduate School Committee.

The final interview will take place in front of a University Committee composed of 8

professors representative of the scientific macro-areas, plus a President nominated by the Rector.

The University Committee has the task to define the general merit list of qualified candidates.

On the basis of the rules of the International School of Advanced Studies, non-EU candidates will be evaluated by the Graduate School Committee only on the basis of their qualifications.

Such qualifications have been presented together with the CV and the application form according to the "Call for non-EU PhD Candidates" (whose deadline was July 31st 2006) and can be only integrated and/or slightly modified within August 31st 2006, sending papers to the same addresses and in the same way as provided in the above mentioned Call.

The monthly amount of the grant is € 900. The sum will be paid in 36 deferred instalments. To qualify for payment of the fellowship the successful applicant's annual income cannot exceed €7,746.85 per annum.

Fellowships will not be awarded to anyone in receipt of any other grant, apart from ones awarded by national or international institutions to pursue part of the scientific studies in another country.

Those who receive a fellowship will be exempted from the payment of tuition fees. For all others enrolling on the PhD courses, the annual tuition fee is €780.00 + €90.00 local administrative fees (i.e. a total of €870.00).

This is to be paid in two instalments: 1) €480.00 (upon enrolling); and 2) € 390.00 (before the 30th of June each year).

Courses will be held mainly in English and will begin in mid-January 2007. Successful candidates are obliged to attend the courses and undertake a programme of continuous study and research within the university according to the direction of the Graduate School Committee. Within the framework of the scientific activities laid down by the Graduate School Committee, the PhD candidates may be involved in placements in public or private enterprises. The PhD candidate can only engage in extra-mural activities with the agreement of the Graduate School Committee and provided that they are temporary, of short duration and do not interfere with the study and research activities.

In case of maternity, military service, serious or prolonged disease, a candidate may interrupt the course or postpone its start.

European candidates are invited to present their application filling out the enclosed form **by September 15th, 2006, as certified by postmark**. They must also add a CV prepared according to the European standard format (see the enclosed format).

The date and place of the selection examination, which will be held in English, will be announced by September 30th on the following website: <http://web.unicam.it> in the section "Avvisi".
