

In order to prevent the spread of COVID-19 infection, UNICAM staff and students

# must notify if they fall under one of the following categories:



## **Symptomatic positive for COVID-19**

They can return to the community after an isolation period of at least 10 days from the onset of positivity, at the end of which a molecular test must be performed, resulting negative (10 days + test).



#### **Asymptomatic positive for COVID-19**

They can return to the community after at least 10 days from the onset of symptoms and a molecular test resulting negative after at least 3 days without symptoms (10 days, of which at least 3 days without symptoms + test).



#### **Long-term positive for COVID-19**

Meaning, those who, even though they no longer present symptoms, continue to result positive to the molecular test. In the event of no symptoms for at least a week, they can interrupt the isolation after 21 days from the onset of symptoms.



#### Close contact with confirmed cases

They must stay in isolation for 14 days starting from the last exposure to a confirmed positive case, or for 10 days starting from the last exposure, if they result negative to an antigen or a molecular test performed on the tenth day.
