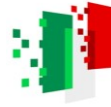

Subject: Selection procedure for the conferral of 4 (four) research collaboration grants within the scope of the PNRR – VITALITY – (Cost Centre STI442001 - Ecosystem Project – PNRR – VITALITY SPOKE 6 – Unique Project Code (CUP) J13C22000430001) - CALL / NOTICE OF SELECTION PROCEDURE

THE RECTOR

HAVING REGARD TO Law No. 240 of 30 December 2010, in particular Art. 22 containing provisions regarding “Research Grants”, in force until 29 June 2022;

HAVING REGARD TO Decree-Law No. 36 of 30 April 2022, converted with amendments by Law No. 79 of 29 June 2022, published in the Official Gazette – General Series - No. 150 of 29 June 2022, which entered into force on 30 June 2022, containing further urgent measures for the implementation of the National Recovery and Resilience Plan (Italian acronym: PNRR), which in art. 14, paragraph 6-septies introduces research contracts, which will replace research grants, specifying in the following paragraph 6-quaterdecies that it will be possible to continue to launch procedures for the awarding of research grants limited to the resources already programmed or approved by the respective governing bodies until 31 December 2022;

HAVING REGARD TO Decree-Law No. 198 of 29 December 2022 (the so-called “Milleproroghe” [one-thousand extensions] decree 2023), converted with amendments by Law No. 14 of 24 February 2023, published in the Official Gazette - General Series – No., 49 of 27 February 2023, which in art. 6, paragraph 1, letter a) modifies the deadline established by law No. 79 of 29 June 2022 to announce the selective procedures for research grants, extending it to 31 December 2023;

HAVING ACKNOWLEDGED that, to date, the University of Camerino has never issued procedures for the award of research contracts;

WITH REFERENCE TO the Regulation still in force on the Conferral of Research Grants, issued with Rector’s Decree No. 6408 of 07 February 2020;

HAVING REGARD TO Ministerial Decree of 9 March 2011, pursuant to Art. 22 of Law No. 240/2010, which established that the minimum amount to be attributed to the holders of research collaboration grants is € 19,367.00;

HAVING REGARD TO Ministerial Decrees of 26 February 1999 and of 04 May 1999, respectively concerning identification and reclassification of academic disciplines in university studies, subsequently amended by Ministerial Decree of 04 October 2000;

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HAVING REGARD TO Law No. 241 of 7 August 1990 and subsequent amendments and additions, containing rules on administrative procedure and the right of access to administrative documents, in compliance with the principles of legality, economy, effectiveness, impartiality and transparency;

HAVING REGARD TO Presidential Decree No. 445 of 28 December 2000, and subsequent amendments, providing for the so-called “Consolidated Act on legislative and regulatory provisions with reference to administrative documentation”;

HAVING REGARD TO Legislative Decree No. 33 of 14 March 2013, as amended by Legislative Decree No. 97 of 25 May 2016, providing for “Reorganisation of the regulation concerning the right of civic access and the obligations of publicity, transparency and dissemination of information by Public Administrations”;

HAVING REGARD TO the University of Camerino signing the declaration of commitment to adopt the European Charter for Researchers and of the Code of Conduct for the Recruitment of Researchers, in July 2005;

WITH REFERENCE TO the Code of Ethical Conduct of the University of Camerino, issued with Rector’s Decree, No. 16 of 3 February 2015, and then recently modified with Rector’s Decree No. 123/2023 Prot. No. 27774 of 19 April 2023;

HAVING ACKNOWLEDGED that the Board of Directors approved the new 2023-2025 Integrated Plan of Activities and Organization (Italian acronym: PIAO) at its meeting on 31 January 2023, which, as required by the Decree-Law No. 80 of 9 June 2021, converted with amendments by Law No. 113 of 06 August 2021, starting from 30 April 2022, contains, as an integral part, the planning of the prevention of corruption and transparency, effectively replacing the Three-year Plan for the Prevention of Corruption and Transparency;

WITH REFERENCE TO the Gender Equality Plan 2022-2024, under which the University of Camerino guarantees equality and equal opportunities for men and women as regards access to employment and related conditions, even with the overcoming of territorial differences;

HAVING REGARD TO Law No. 127 of 15 May 1997, in particular art. 3, paragraph 7, which provides for a preference in favour of the younger candidate as a preferential element in the recruitment of personnel in the event of an equal score;

CONSIDERING that the Ministry of University and Research is the assignee of resources for the implementation of the interventions of the PNRR in the context of Mission 4 - Component 2 “From research to business” (hereinafter “M4C2”);



HAVING ACKNOWLEDGED that within the scope of Mission 4, Component 2 “From research to business” intends to strengthen research and encourage the dissemination of innovative models for basic and applied research conducted in synergy between universities and businesses, support processes for innovation and technology transfer, strengthen research infrastructures, capital and skills to support innovation;

HAVING REGARD TO Director’s Decree no. 3277 of 30 December 2021, with which the public notice was issued for the presentation of intervention proposals for the creation and strengthening of “innovation ecosystems”, for the construction of “territorial R&D leaders” - Innovation Ecosystems - under the National Recovery and Resilience Plan, Mission 4 Education and research - Component 2 From research to business - Investment 1.5, funded by the European Union – NextGenerationEU and the related Directorial Decree No. 1057 of 23 June 2022 for admission to the financing;

HAVING REGARD TO the Director’s Decree for admission to financing No. 1057 of 23 June 2022, which approved the funding of €115,996,558.73 for the implementation of the Innovation, digitalisation, and sustainability for the widespread economy in Central Italy project - VITALITY project;

HAVING REGARD TO the mandatory deed sent by e-mail to the Rector and the Director General of the University of Camerino on 5 August 2022, which indicates the terms and conditions of the Decree for admission to financing (Director’s Decree No 1057 of 23 June 2022), and which dictates the timetable for the implementation of the VITALITY project;

WITH REFERENCE TO the Resolution of the Board of the School of Architecture and Design No. 139 of 14 December 2022, concerning the request for activation of 4 (four) research grant within the scope of the PNRR Ecosystem Project – “Vitality Spoke 6”;

WITH REFERENCE TO the resolutions of the Board of Directors and the Academic Senate, relating to their meetings of 20 December 2022, with which the activation of the aforementioned research grant was approved;

ASCERTAINED the financial availability for the conferral of the above-mentioned 4 (four) two-year research grants, including all the charges for which the Entity is responsible, equal to € 56.000,00 (28.000/year) for each grant, which shall be borne by the cost centre/project: “VITALITY – Spoke 6” CUP J13C22000430001;

DECREES

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Art. 1 Subject

Three (3) selection procedures, based only qualifications and an interview, for conferral of 4 (four) research grants for the carrying out of research activities at the School and for the research project indicated below, is now open:

SCHOOL OF ARCHITECTURE AND DESIGN

1) 2 (two) research grants

Academic Discipline: ICAR/13 (Industrial design)

Research Area: 08 - Civil Engineering and Architecture

Research Project Title: *“Design for the safety of living environments in the era of digital transition: development of sustainable and life-saving furniture systems and their enhancement through the creation of a digital tool”.*

Research Activity to be carried out: The research project in question is part of the Ecosystems of Innovation project: “Vitality. Innovation, digitisation, and sustainability for the widespread economy of Central Italy”, funded by the PNRR, and in particular in Spoke 6 “Innovation and safety of living environments in the era of digital transition”, coordinated by the University of Camerino. The research, linked to the main themes of Spoke 6, focuses on the design skills for environmental sustainability and circularity, for product innovation and for the digital valorisation of the project results. It requires knowledge of sustainable product design methodologies and strategies and tools for digital enhancement and communication. The research is aimed at the development and prototyping of innovative products in terms of eco-sustainability, circularity, and safety, linked to the furniture industry, and their enhancement through design and digital tools.

Head of Research Project: Prof. Lucia Pietroni

Admission requirements and qualifications: Masters’ Degree in Design (Class LM-12)

Duration of the grant: 24 months (with the possibility of renewal)

Gross annual amount to be paid to the grant recipient: € 22,699.00/year.

Grant cost centre: STI442001 “VITALITY – Spoke 6” - CUP J13C22000430001

Qualifications valid for evaluation: Training and specialization courses, masters, professional experiences, research experiences, prizes, and awards.

Good knowledge of English language is requested.



Indication of the deadline for submitting the application: 30 days from the date of publication of the Notice of Competition;

Procedure method: Based on qualifications and an interview;

Scores: Qualifications: 40 points; Interview: 60 points.

2) 1 (one) research grant

Academic Discipline: ICAR/09 (Construction techniques)

Research Area: 08 - Civil Engineering and Architecture

Research Project Title: “*Structural monitoring to support evaluation of existing buildings*”.

Research Activity to be carried out: Combined use of contact sensors and techniques based on image analysis for long-term monitoring. Development of a system for tracking structural displacements starting from images acquired by cameras and processed using artificial vision algorithms. Updating of structural models and automatic systems for identifying variations in response. Exploration of surrogate models supported by experimental data through Bayesian inference as an intermediate step between physical reality and advanced finite element models. Application to real case studies of long-term structural monitoring systems.

Admission requirements and qualifications: Master’s Degree in Civil Engineering (class LM -23)

Duration of the grant: 24 months (with the possibility of renewal)

Gross annual amount to be paid to the grant recipient: € 22,699.00/year.

Grant cost centre: STI442001 “VITALITY – Spoke 6” - CUP J13C22000430001

Qualifications valid for evaluation: Scientific publications, post-graduate training courses, attendance of specialised seminars.

Good knowledge of English language is requested.

Indication of the deadline for submitting the application: 30 days from the date of publication of the Notice of Competition;

Procedure method: Based on qualifications and an interview;

Scores: Qualifications: 40 points; Interview: 60 points.



3) 1 (one) research grant

Academic Discipline: ICAR/12 (Architecture technology)

Research Area: 08 - Civil Engineering and Architecture

Research Project Title: *“Indoor and outdoor spaces at the centre of the ecological and digital transition of living environments (Digital environments for planning design strategies for climate adaptation of indoor and outdoor urban spaces and heat island mitigation)”*.

Research Activity to be carried out: The research is part of the “Vitality” project, Innovation ecosystem, funded by the PNRR, coordinated by the University of L’Aquila, and in particular at Spoke 6 “Innovation and safety of living environments in the digital transition era”, coordinated by Prof. Flavio Corradini of the University of Camerino, section 6.1 “Indoor and outdoor at the centre of the digital and green transition of living environments”. The research aims to define an operational methodology which, through the construction of a replicable digital model referring to the LCZ (Local Climate Zones), based on the integration of GIS and BIM (CIM) technologies, makes it possible to evaluate the effects of design solutions from a climatic-environmental point of view, with particular reference to the general objective of defining a catalogue of “UHI (Urban Heat Island) impact solutions”.

Admission requirements and qualifications: Master’s Degree in Architecture (class LM -4)

Duration of the grant: 24 months (with the possibility of renewal)

Gross annual amount to be paid to the grant recipient: € 22,699.00/year.

Grant cost centre: STI442001 “VITALITY – Spoke 6” - CUP J13C22000430001

Qualifications valid for evaluation: Masters, professional experiences, teaching activities, related to the topics of the research project.

Good knowledge of English language is requested.

Indication of the deadline for submitting the application: 30 days from the date of publication of the Notice of Competition;

Procedure method: Based on qualifications and an interview;

Scores: Qualifications: 40 points; Interview: 60 points.

Art. 2

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Requirements for participation in the selection procedure

The following shall be admitted to the selection procedure for the conferral of research grants:

- Candidates in possession of a Masters' degree in the Class indicated in Art. 1 of this Notice of Competition;

- Candidates having a scientific-professional curriculum suitable for carrying out the research activity.

The aforementioned admission requirements must be met on the expiry date of this call for applications, under penalty of exclusion.

Foreign citizens must be in possession of a degree equivalent to those previously mentioned. Equivalence must be certified by competent authorities.

Research grants shall not be awarded to permanent staff members at universities, public research and experimentation agencies and institutions, the Italian National Agency for New Technologies, Energy and Sustainable Development (ENEA), the Italian Aerospace Agency (ASI), as well as at the institutions conferring scientific specialisation degrees recognised as equivalent to a PhD degree pursuant to Art. 74, paragraph 4 of Presidential Decree. No. 382 of 11 July 1980.

Candidates excluded from the active political electorate shall not be admitted to the selection procedure.

Foreign citizens must also meet the following requirements:

- a) enjoying full civil and political rights in the Country of origin or provenance;
- b) meeting all the requirements necessary for the Italian citizens, except for the Italian citizenship,
- c) having adequate knowledge of the Italian language.

Pursuant to Art. 18, paragraph 1, letters b) and c) of the Law No. 240/2010 and Art. 1, paragraph 3 of the Regulations, candidates having a degree of kinship or affinity, up to and including the fourth degree, with a Professor working at the School publishing the proposal for the activation of the contract, or with the Rector, Director-General, or a member of the University's Board of Governors, shall not be admitted to the selection procedure.

Furthermore, candidates who have already been awarded research grants by any institution, pursuant to Law No. 240/2010, for a period exceeding 6 years when summed up with the duration of this grant, shall not be admitted to this selection procedure. If the grant has been awarded during a PhD programme without a scholarship and up to the legal duration of the course, that period is not counted.

Furthermore, candidates who have held contracts as research fellows or fixed-term researchers, pursuant to Articles 22 and 24 of Law No. 240/2010, with the University of Camerino or



any other Italian university, government, non-government or online, or with institutions described in Art. 22, paragraph 22 of Law No. 240/2010, for a period exceeding 12 years, when summed up with the duration of this grant, even if not continuous, shall not be admitted to this selection procedure.

Periods spent on maternity leave or sick leave, according to the current legislation, shall not be taken into account for the purposes of the duration of the aforementioned work relationships.

The Administration may order, at any time, with a motivated provision, the exclusion from the selection procedure due to lack of the prescribed requisites.

Art. 3

Application and presentation deadline

The application and the related attachments must be submitted exclusively through the computer application system adopted, available at the link indicated on the webpage on which the Notice of the Selection Procedure was published.

For the online submission of the application, candidates must have an ordinary e-mail address (not certified e-mail), for the purposes of registering with the system. Registration must be done at the time of first access.

Please note that the e-mail address indicated by the candidate during registration will be used by this Administration for all subsequent communications relating to the selection procedure in question.

All information needed for the correct completion and submission of the application is available in the “*Guide to completing the online application*”, published on the application form home page.

The application must be submitted exclusively through the online procedure indicated in the Notice, containing the following wording, which differs according to the position announced:

Applications presented in ways other than online will not be considered admissible and therefore will be excluded.

Applications for participation must be sent electronically, under penalty of exclusion, by 01:00 p.m. (Italian time) on the thirtieth day following that of publication of this Notice on the Unicam website.

If the deadline of the Notice falls on a Saturday or a public holiday, the deadline will be postponed to the first next working day.

Each candidate can send only one application.

The application and its attachments must be sent in one of the following formats: PDF, JPG, JPEG, PNG (maximum size for each attachment 5MB).

Successful application and date of receipt of the application is certified by the computer system by means of a receipt, which will be automatically sent to the e-mail address provided by the candidate during registration.

The computer application system for submitting the application will remain active even on any days when the University is closed.

After the deadline for submitting applications, the system will no longer allow submissions.

Assistance with the online compilation may be requested by sending a specific support request directly from within the platform and will be suspended starting from the twenty-ninth day from publication of the Notice, and until the deadline for the online compilation and submission of the application.

It should also be noted that in the week from 14 August to 19 August 2023, following the University's summer closure, immediate assistance will not be guaranteed in completing the application form electronically.

In the application, candidates must declare, assuming full civil, criminal and administrative responsibility, the following:

- 1) Their last name, first name, and tax code;
- 2) Place and date of birth;
- 3) Residence;
- 4) Contact details chosen for the purposes of this selection (in particular, the domicile if different from the residence, the ordinary e-mail address to which all communications relating to this selection procedure should be sent, and the mobile phone number);
- 5) Italian citizenship and the related enjoyment of civil and political rights;
- 6) Not having been excluded from active political electorate;
- 7) Not having been disqualified from holding public offices or not having been dismissed (fired for disciplinary reasons), or not having been exempted from employment in a public administration due to persistent insufficient performance, or not having been declared forfeited from a state job for having obtained it through the production of false documents or vitiated by non-amendable invalidity;



- 8) Not having any criminal convictions, or any pending criminal proceedings (otherwise, indicate which ones);
- 9) That a permanent psychophysical unsuitability for service in the Public Administrations has not been ascertained;
- 10) The Degree obtained with the date on which the degree was awarded and the University from which it was obtained, pursuant to art. 46 of Presidential Decree no. 445/2000;
- 11) The PhD degree, if any, the date on which the degree was awarded and the University from which the degree was obtained, pursuant to art. 46 of Presidential Decree no. 445/2000;
- 12) To hold no other scholarship, fellowship or research grant, and undertaking to renounce them in case of becoming successful candidates in this selection procedure;
- 13) Having no degree of kinship or affinity, up to and including the fourth degree, with a Professor working at the School publishing the Notice, or with the Rector, Director-General, or a member of the University's Board of Governors; Failure to present this last declaration shall result in the exclusion from the procedure;
- 14) Not having been the holder, or having been the holder of research grants, indicating in the latter case the duration;
- 15) Not having been the holder or having been the holder of a fixed-term Researcher contract, indicating in the latter case the duration;
- 16) That they authorise the University of Camerino to publish their curriculum, without personal data, on the website.

In particular, Citizens of the Member States of the European Union and citizens of non-EU countries must also declare that they enjoy civil and political rights in the Country of their origin or provenance, or the reasons for the non-enjoyment of the same, and that they have adequate knowledge of the Italian language;

Candidates with disabilities, pursuant to Law No. 104 of 05 February 1992, in their application must make an explicit request in relation to their disability and regarding the aid necessary for the completion of the interview.

Candidates must attach the following to the application:

- 1) **Curriculum vitae, bearing their signature and the date.** A copy of the curriculum, omitting the personal data (pursuant to Art. 4, paragraph 3 of Legislative Decree No. 33/2013), must also be sent in PDF format to one of the following e-mail address: gloria.gentilucci@unicam.it, in order to have it published on the University website; The curriculum must contain a special declaration in lieu of affidavit, in which it is declared that what is reported in the same is true, pursuant to articles 19 and 47 of Presidential Decree No. 445/2000.
- 2) **All the qualifications considered useful for the purposes of the assessment and the relative list** (publications, degree theses, any doctoral theses, course certificates, various diplomas, etc.), pursuant to articles 19 and 47 of Presidential Decree No. 445/2000. It should be noted that any



publications in a foreign language must be produced in the original language; the same must be translated into Italian or French or English or German or Spanish, only if the original is produced in a language other than those already mentioned.

3) Degree(s) obtained abroad, required for admission to this selection:

- a) original copy or a copy authenticated by an Italian authority, notarised and accompanied by a certified or sworn translation;
- b) with attached declaration of value or the transcripts of the exams taken, relative to the degree required for participation;

In order to ensure the broadest possible participation in the procedure, candidates unable to present a degree obtained abroad when submitting the application, as indicated in the previous paragraph, must enclose with the application a photocopy of the degree accompanied by translation in Italian or English, and later, in case of successful candidates, obligatorily present the original degree, or authenticated copy of the same. A foreign qualification can be declared admissible by the Selection Committee, for the sole purpose of admission to this procedure.

4) A copy of a valid identity document;

The University Administration reserves the right to verify the veracity and authenticity of the statements produced.

Candidates are admitted to the selection with reserve (conditional admission).

The Administration may order at any time, with its own motivated provision, even after the interview has taken place, the exclusion from the selection itself, due to lack of the prescribed requisites.

The exclusion will be communicated directly, by e-mail, to the interested party.

Art. 4

Selection Committee and selection procedure

Each Selection Committee is appointed by Rector's Decree, and is made up of the Head of Research Project and two other members, as well as a substitute member, Professors or Researchers, belonging to the academic discipline relating to the project or to the related sector.

If the funds for the disbursement of the grant derive in whole or in part from external funding, a member of the Committee may be an expert, indicated by the funding body, with particular documented competence with respect to the subject of the research program. The external member shall also be subject to the rules of the University's Code of Ethics



The Committee shall be made known by publishing the nomination decree on the University website, together with the individual names of the Committee members and their curricula.

The selection procedure shall be based on the evaluation of qualifications and publications and can may be followed by an interview.

When evaluating the qualifications, the Selection Committee shall consider the doctoral degree or equivalent qualification obtained abroad as a preferential qualification.

When evaluating the qualifications, only publications and specific qualifications relevant to the research activity to be carried out and showing the level of scientific and professional qualification achieved by the candidates will be taken into account.

The interview will focus on topics related to the research project chosen by the candidate and will be aimed at ascertaining the aptitude for research and the professional capacity required for the performance of the tasks to which the selection procedure refers. During the interview, the knowledge of the foreign language requested in the Notice of Competition may also be verified.

At the end of each meeting, the Committee shall draw up a specific report.

At the conclusion of each selection procedure, each Selection Committee, based on the evaluation of qualifications and publications and on the basis of the interview, will define the suitability or otherwise of each candidate and will draw up a ranking list of the suitable candidates.

With regard to scientific production, each Committee shall also evaluate the degree of creativity and autonomy shown by the candidate.

In case of renunciation of the successful candidates before the beginning of the activity, or in case of early termination due to unjustified failure to start the research activity, the grants may be conferred to suitable candidates, according to the order of the respective ranking lists.

The Rector, by Rector's Decree, shall ascertain the regularity of the acts of the selection procedure, consisting of the minutes of each meeting of the Committee, and shall approves the ranking list, which shall be immediately effective.

The results of each selection procedure shall be communicated to the winner of the grant, who will be invited to enter into a private-law contract in which the contractual rights and obligations shall be indicated.

This contract does not in any way constitute an employment contract and does not give any right with regard to access to the tenured positions at the University.

No communication shall be sent to any other candidates, who will be able to find out the results of the selection procedure from a Decree approving the procedure acts, published on the University website, "Personnel" - "Selection Procedures" - "Research grant selection procedures" - "Closed procedures, and in the UNICAM online notice board (<https://titulus-unicam.cineca.it/albo/>).



Art. 5

Conferral of the research grant

The grant shall be effective from the first day of the month following the Rector's Decree approving the selection procedure documents, unless there is a subsequent starting date resulting from the programs of the research structure and from agreements between the parties.

The research activity must be continuous. The methods of carrying out the research are governed by the organisational provisions in force at the School.

The grant is normally paid in deferred monthly instalments.

Accident insurance coverage is guaranteed to grant holders, in accordance with current legislation.

The grant holder may withdraw, subject to thirty days' notice or a shorter term, if justified. In the event of withdrawal within three months of the effective date, the grant made available is attributed until the original deadline to the first candidate placed in a useful position on the ranking list of the corresponding selection.

Art. 6

Renewal

The research grant, subject to a reasoned request from the Head of Research Project, approved by the School Council, can be renewed in compliance with the maximum limit of 36 months: however, the duration of the renewal can never be less than six months.

Art. 7

Incompatibility, rights and duties

Incompatibility, rights and duties are established in Articles 8 and 9 of the Research Grant Regulations available on the website of the University of Camerino, in section: "University – Organisation of our University – Regulations – Research".

Art. 8

Head of the Research Project

Head of the Research Project is a Full Professor or Senior Researcher, under whose guidance and direction the research activities envisaged by the grant are carried out.

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Art. 9 Personal data processing
