

## The Rector

**Having regard to** the University Statute, issued with Rector's Decree No. 194 of 30 July 2012, and published in the Official Gazette of the Italian Republic - General Series – Part One, No. 200 of 28 August 2012;

**Having regard to** the Code of Ethics and Conduct issued with Rector's Decree No. 16 of 03 February 2015;

**Having regard to** the Regulations of the PhD programmes and of the School of Advanced Studies, issued with Rector's Decree No. 30817 of 06 May 2022;

**Having regard to** the call for applications for admission to the PhD programme in "THEORETICAL AND APPLIED NEUROSCIENCE (Cycle XXXVIII, Academic Year 2022/2023), issued with Rector's Decree No. 242, Protocol No. 0046933 of 06 July 2020;

**Considering** that there were no suitable candidates to fill in some of the PhD positions identified with the codes: 1.4, 1.7, 3.4, 3.6, 3.8, 3.10, 3.17, and 4.8, sito web <https://isas.unicam.it/dni/phd-tan/how-apply>, and consequently the assignment of the aforementioned scholarships was cancelled;

## DECREES

### Art. 1- EXTENSION OF DEADLINES FOR THE SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS

The deadline for submitting applications to participate in the selection, limited to the PhD scholarships identified with the codes: 1.4, 1.7, 3.4, 3.6, 3.8, 3.10, 3.17, 4.8, has been extended to Wednesday 19 October 2022.

The application for participation in the selection must be completed exclusively (under penalty of exclusion from the selection / admission procedure) on the format accessible from the website <https://vele.unicam.it/CallforApplication/?st=2> by Wednesday 19 October 2022 at 23:59 CEST

It is the responsibility of the candidate to verify the correct conclusion of the IT procedure.

Applications received after the deadline and with methods other than those indicated above will not be considered valid.

The assessment of suitability of candidates for admission to the PhD Programme will be carried out on Thursday, 20 October 2022, by a Selection Committee appointed by the Rector of the coordinating office (University of Camerino), with its own decree, and its composition will be available on the SAS website.

Candidates deemed suitable in this first phase will be invited to take an oral exam to be held online on 21 October 2022.

The list of candidates admitted to the second phase will be published on the Unicam official website and on page <https://isas.unicam.it/dni/phd-tan/how-apply>. No personal communications will be sent: the publication of the short list has the value of official communication to the interested parties.

The final ranking will be published on the UNICAM official website, and on the SAS website on page <https://isas.unicam.it/dni/phd-tan/how-apply>.
