

## Prof. Giulia Bonacucina



Prof. Giulia Bonacucina received her degree cum laude in Chemistry and Pharmaceutical Technologies in 1999 and her PhD in Pharmaceutical Sciences in 2004 from the University of Camerino. She has carried out research periods at foreign institutions such as the "Bristol Colloid Centre" of the University of Bristol (UK), the Faculty of Pharmacy of the "Queen's University of Belfast" and the Faculty of Pharmacy of the "Université Paris Malabry (Paris). In 2004 she was the winner of the "L'ORÉAL ITALIA for Women and Science" award and in 2014 she obtained the third place in the Business Plan Competition "Start Cup Marche 2014", with the project "Pharma, Food and Cosmetics". Currently, she works as Associate Professor at the School of Pharmacy of the University of Camerino where she is Professor in Pharmaceutical Technology and coordinator of the degree course in Pharmacy. The research activity of Giulia Bonacucina, which led to the publication of 138 papers on international journals (H-index 32) and of 4 book chapters, mainly concerns the preparation and chemical-physical characterization of colloidal systems (micelles, microemulsions and nanoparticles) and self-assembling materials (polymers and surfactants). Prof Bonacucina is also co-founder and President of "Pharma & Food Consulting Srl", spin off of the University of Camerino.
