Guido Favia is Full Professor of Parasitology and parasitic diseases of animals.

His research activity mainly consists of studying the interactions between microorganisms and mosquitoes vectors of microbial pathogens.

He is the author of over 110 scientific publications in high-impact scientific journals, including Science, Pnas, Current Biology, mBio and others.

He acts as an evaluator for numerous national and international scientific bodies, including the ERC, the ANF, the Wellcome Trust, and for many scientific journals. He has held scientific talks in numerous and prestigious venues both in Italy and abroad.

He has coordinated many national and international research projects, some of which are still ongoing, obtaining research funding of around three million euros.

Since 2019 he has been Director of the Italian Malaria Network. He has received numerous scientific awards and recognitions in his career, including the Battista Grassi Award from the Italian Society of Parasitology.
