Her research focuses on Contract Law, Family Law, Bioethics Law, and Energy and Sustainability Law, with particular attention to citizens' rights and access to justice. She is a member of the Scientific Committee of the Jean Monnet Chair CLOSER – Cross-border families, family reunifications and Succession matters, co-funded by the EU Erasmus+ Programme. She is a member Research Team of the School of Reconstruction and Resilience (SECURE), University of Camerino, a member Research Team of International Center for Research on the Sciences and Techniques of Physical, Economic and Social Reconstruction (STRIC) and a member Research Team of Strengthening the International Center for Research on the Sciences and Techniques of Reconstruction (STRIC+), University of Camerino.
