Virtual camp "Chinese Bridge" language and culture

The **University of Camerino** together with the Chinese partner university of **Jilin Agricultural University** invite you to participate in the "**Chinese Bridge**" virtual camp on Chinese language and culture. The virtual camp lasts 10 mornings and will always be held from 08.40 to 11.50 using the "Chinese Plus" platform (<https://www.chinese-plus.net/>). The camp will start on **September 1st 2022 and will end on September 16th 2022**.

Any non-Chinese applicant of the following groups are entitled to apply:

- a) fixed-term and permanent administrative staff in service at UNICAM, collaborators and collaborators with contracts of autonomous nature;
- b) UNICAM teaching staff;
- c) holders of research grants, scholarships or research grants activated by UNICAM;
- d) the students of the specialization courses, of the PhD courses, of the specialization courses of UNICAM;
- e) students of study courses (Bachelor Degree, Master Degree and Integrated Master Degree) and Italian master's courses (1° and 2° levels) activated by UNICAM.

Participants are ONLY required to have an adequate knowledge of the English language.

The topics are:

- Chinese language (at least 15 hours);
- Silk Culture;
- Tea Culture;
- Chinese cuisine: combination of meat, vegetable and mushroom dishes;
- Scientific breeding in China;
- History and cultivation of maize in China;
- Four seasons in Chinese agricultural culture;
- Virtual visit to agricultural research base.

The participation is free of charge and has a limited number of participants: the maximum number of participants is 60. Applications will be accepted based on the chronological order of arrival. Applications must be **submitted by 13:00 (CEST) of 22/08/2022 exclusively in online** modality by sending the request for participation (written in Italian or in English) to the following e-mail address: **china@unicam.it**

In the request, applicants must indicate:

- 1) surname and name;
- 2) citizenship;
- 3) gender;
- 4) birthday and birth place;
- 5) mobile number;
- 6) e-mail address.

Please note that communications will mainly be made electronically using only the e-mail address that the candidate has indicated. Applications submitted after the deadline or in a manner different from online modality shall not be taken into consideration. Registration will be official only after you have received a confirmation e-mail from the organizing secretariat.

At the end, a certificate of attendance will be issued by the "Center for Language Education and Cooperation" (CLEC) of the Chinese Ministry of Education after having checked attendance at least 70% of the expected total number of hours.
